Methodist Homes (MHA) Coming to Gravesend

In addition to operating residential care homes and retirement living schemes for older people throughout the country, MHA also provides services for older people who continue to live in their own properties. Formally known as 'Live at Home,' 'MHA Communities' provide activities designed to improve well-being, reduce loneliness and isolation and signpost to other providers and services. GMCCC and MHA Communities' Kent have been in discussions since before the pandemic and we are delighted that we will soon be launching in Gravesend. Together with our care home in Whitstable, our Retirement Living and Community Scheme in Folkestone and our recently launched telephone befriending services and digital activities throughout the county, our partnership with GMCCC will form the foundations of our mission to ensure that the older people of Kent live later life well.

MHA Communities Kent will be opening a community coffee shop and also running social, intergenerational and seated exercise sessions in the new foyer area. The community coffee shop will operate initially from 10am to 2pm on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and will welcome everyone, regardless of age. There will be a simple but nutritious and affordable snacks and drinks menu. The organised activities will be open to anyone over 55 years of age who would like to become a member of MHA Communities. The full programme of activities and coffee shop menu will be published in the next few weeks alongside details of how to become a member.

MHA rely on the input of thousands of volunteers, mainly members of local Methodist Churches, to help to deliver all activities. Whatever your abilities, skills or life experiences there is a role for you. Please consider giving your time to help improve the lives of older people in Gravesend.
