

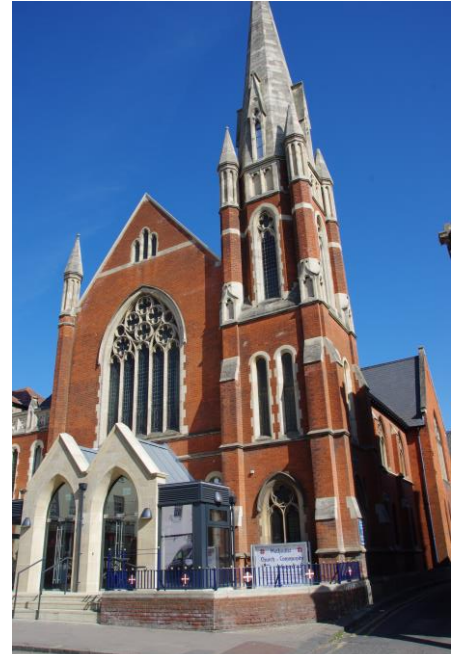
Gravesend Methodist Church & Community Centre
