Our Rev Alex read out a letter in church last Sunday; for anyone not there, here is a synopsis:-Our Circuit and District have been discussing how best to organise this circuits minsters and churches from September 2026 and have agreed the following:-

The Rev Bonni-Belle Pickard retires in September 2026 and the Rex Alex Terrett will be moving into the manse at Maidstone; taking over as Superintendent minister for at least a year and will be responsible for churches in Maidstone. The minister responsible for The Brent church in Dartford will change to the Rev Rocky Chan from September 2027.

It is hoped that a new minister will be appointed for our church and Deneholm and who will also be appointed as a Deputy District Chair (1/3 of his time being devoted to District matters). (The District has 3 deputy district chairs and this new minister will be responsible for most of Kent). Toward the end of November/early December we should know whether or who our new minister will be from September 2026.

So, we all need to PRAY about these changes, 'that they will go smoothly and successfully'.


