

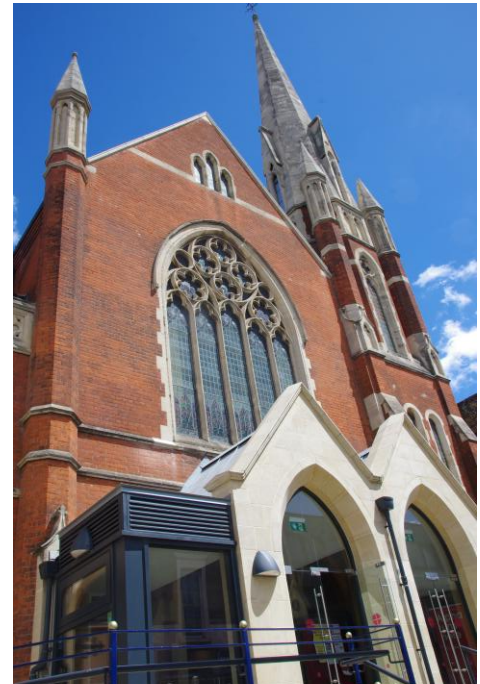

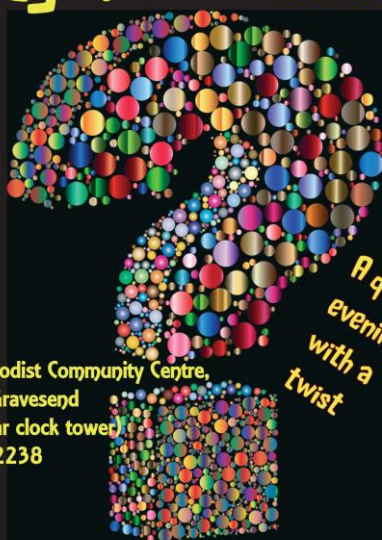
"Your local Town Centre Church bringing God's love to the heart of the community".
